Vertical Belt/Chain Guard





Recommendations:

Uniguard Vertical Belt Guards can be created with many custom options not normally incorporated in non-compliant OSHA guards as follows:

- Inspection windows can be placed on width panels to allow maintenance to check belt tension or on front panels for checking RPM.
- Lifting handles are optional for easy guard removal.
- Removable front panel for belt/chain maintenance.
- Slotted cover is optional for heat dissipation.
- Back panels are normally center split but can be flanged when shaft is on the same side.

Descriptions:

- Vertical guards are normally center split when both drive and driven shafts are directly mounted over each whether on the same or opposing sides.
- Flanged back option can be either a solid or split panel. A flanged back allows the end user to install the 9/16" HDPE back panel to the equipment and then securing the rest of the guard to this attached back panel eliminating the need of securing the quard to the foundation.
